

Call for papers. special issue of the *Journal of Beliefs and Values: studies in religion and education*, 'Faith in the Public Square'.

Special edition editors: Professor Stephen Parker, University of Worcester and the Rev'd Dr John Reader, William Temple Foundation and the University of Worcester.

2016 marks the 75th anniversary of the Malvern Conference, a conference convened by the renowned Archbishop William Temple to examine matters on church and society particularly from an Anglican perspective at the height of the Second World War.

Recognising the obviously changed circumstances culturally and socially since then, this special issue invites contributions under the theme 'faith in the public sphere' broadly understood. Particular contributions will be welcome which reframe the debate in relation to the role of religion in society in the areas of education, healthcare, finance, environmental concerns and policy-making, theologically, historically, theoretically, conceptually or empirically.

All submissions will be subject to editorial and peer-review, and will be selected on the basis of relevance, balance of themes across the special issue and overall quality. Should submissions be considered beyond the scope of the special issue, articles will be open for consideration for publication in subsequent editions of the journal.
